Which is your favourite and why?

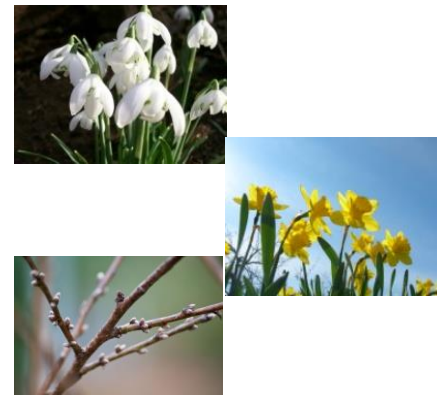
Look at the different types of buildings around where you live (or look up some unusual ones on the internet and bring photos in).

Draw and write about their similarities and differences.



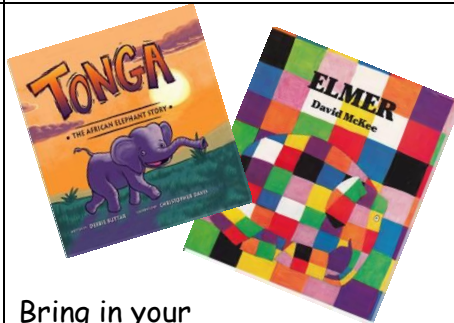
Or draw a picture of your house and label the features e.g. roof, chimney, door, etc.

Look for signs of spring. Collect, take photos/ make a list/tables and count the animals, birds, colours, plants (spring bulbs/buds) and anything else that you see.



Make a list of African animals and something that you like about them e.g. I like a zebra because of the stripes.

Which animals are endangered? Can you find out?



Bring in your favourite animals poem, story or a book about animals for us to share.



Make an animal mask or a model of an animal.
